

Honored with a visit



Moishy the Middos Mentsch



Moishy the Middos Mentsch has come to visit Pre1A! Moishy comes to visit the class on a weekly basis and introduces a new *middah* each time. The Middos Mentsch program is a social skills program where the boys learn all about how to tune into one another, recognizing their own feelings, reading their friends' body language, paying attention

when someone is talking, how to be assertive while still being respectful and many other things pertaining to friendship and communication. This program is extremely age-appropriate and helpful as the boys are learning to navigate the world around them and to communicate appropriately with one another. Each week the boys bring home a folder with the *middah* of the week

and a fun page to do. Each time a boy brings in a completed worksheet or a Middos Mentsch mail from home, he receives a baseball sticker. Boys also receive baseballs throughout the day as they demonstrate the middah of that week. Each time they get a "home-run", they get to put in a raffle ticket and at the end of the week, each participating boy receives a prize. What a fun way to work on good Middos!
