At Yeshiva Darchei Noam, science is studied hands-on and with real world connections.



As part of the physical science unit they are studying, the seventh graders engaged in hands-on experiments with bubbles, to learn about concepts in physics such as surface tension and pressure.

They also visited Monsey's Fireside restaurant in the Town Square Mall, where Chef Alex Remer conducted a demonstration of chemical reactions in the

preparation

food such as the Maillard effect. They learned about emulsification, fermentation, crystallization, and oxidation. To connect to their Kodesh studies.
