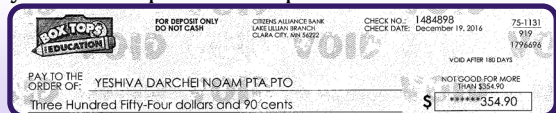
Pure Nachas!

A "Fireside" Chat

At Yeshiva Darchei Noam, science is studied hands-on and with real world connections.



As part of the physical science unit they are studying, the seventh graders engaged in hands-on experiments with bubbles, to learn about concepts in physics such as surface tension and pressure.

They also visited Monsey's Fireside restaurant in the Town Square Mall, where Chef Alex Remer conducted a demonstration of chemical reactions in the preparation of

food such as the Maillard effect. They learned about emulsification, fermentation, crystallization, and oxidation. To connect to their *Kodesh* studies, Rabbi Yechezkel Auerbach, director of Independent Kashrus Research LLC and Senior Rabbinic Coordinator at KSA, described to our students via SKYPE, how food chemistry comes to play in Halachic decisions in Kashrus.
