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
Total Participation and Cooperative Learning

They'll surely remember the story of the שורוק, who thought that he had learned a lesson from his friend הוולם. He knew what had happened to חולם and the ball that




was thrown too high, but look what ended up happening to him! To help the *talmidim* integrate it, *Morah* encourages them to repeat the story to their family and friends.
