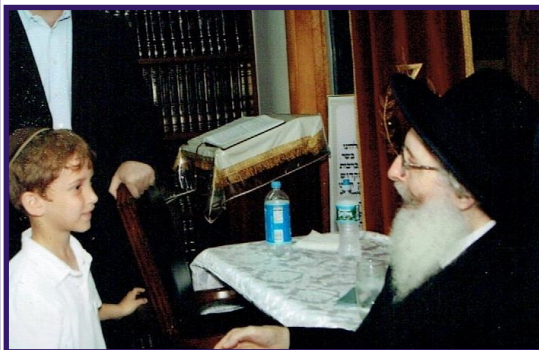
### Learning with the Rosh HaYeshiva
