The Business Office is closed for two weeks over the summer (dates TBD).

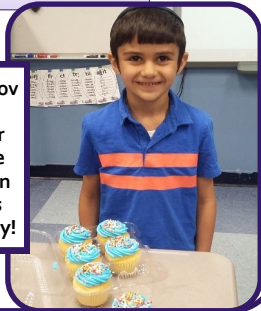
