This past week, the Pre-1A enjoyed a trip to *Eretz Yisrael*. Previous to the upcoming fast of *Asarah B'Teves*, the Pre-1A Moros decided to help the boys get a feeling for *Eretz Yisrael* while in their classroom. Of course, in order to go on a special trip like that, one must first prepare properly, and so the week was filled with all sorts of preparations including learning all about *Yerushalayim*.

First and foremost, each boy needed a passport. In order to apply for one, the students wrote down their name and Hebrew birthday. An official passport photo was then taken.

As they learned about the walls of *Yerushalayim*, the Pre-1A boys worked together and built a stunning montage which looks like the walls surrounding the

Old City. They also decorated the bricks of the kosel and were given an understanding of our desire to actually stand there davening in person. Each boy chose one or more mitzvos which he wanted to do in order to help build the Bais Hamikdash. When the boys went home, they packed suitcases with all that they felt was needed for their trip. Special luggage tags were then attached to the travel bags. Once the boys arrived at the airport for the YKOR Airlines flight, they each needed to answer some questions on the long security lines. They then boarded the plane, stowed their luggage, sat in their assigned seats and fastened their seatbelts. After the plane took off, there was an impressive slideshow of some of the many beautiful places in Eretz Yisrael. Airline meals under the special airline logo were served to the passengers. When they disembarked, the travelers went first off to daven at the Kosel. During davening, kvitlach were placed in the cracks of the wall. The boys asked Hashem for many things as they stood quietly and respectfully during the tefillos at the Kosel which were followed by an impromptu kumzitz of Ani Maamin, as the Pre-1 Aers asked Hashem to please bring Mashiach.
