Last Sunday, February 11, there was a momentous *Hascholas Gemara* Celebration. Each participating student learned with his father with complete

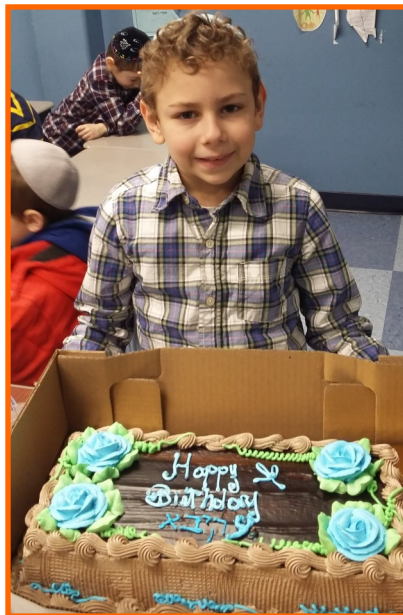


hasmadah during the celebration. The post learning dancing that the *talmidim* participated in captured the appropriate exuberance and *simcha* felt for the occasion.

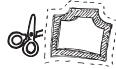

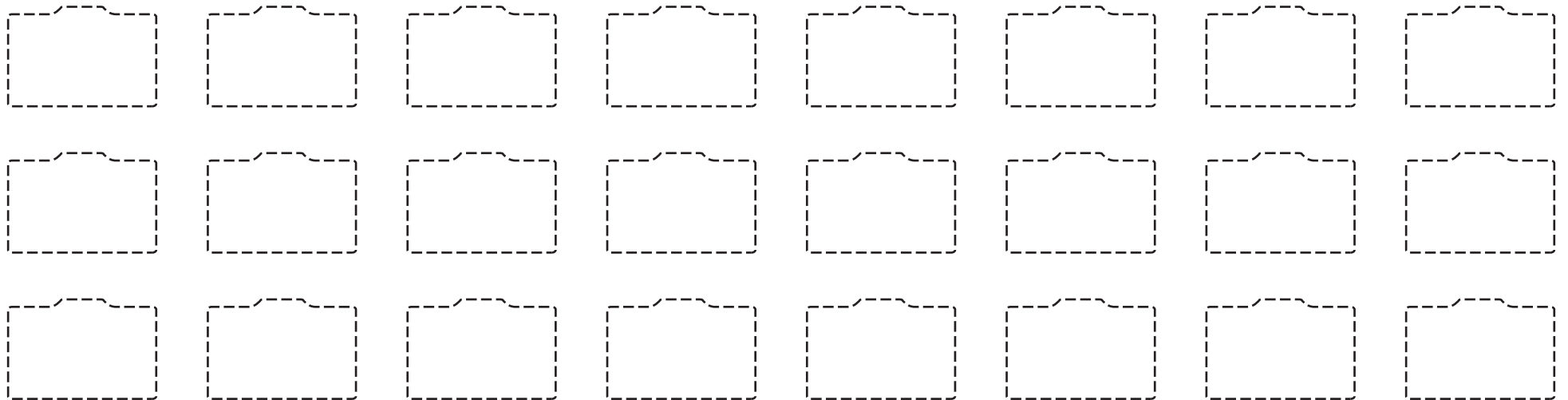
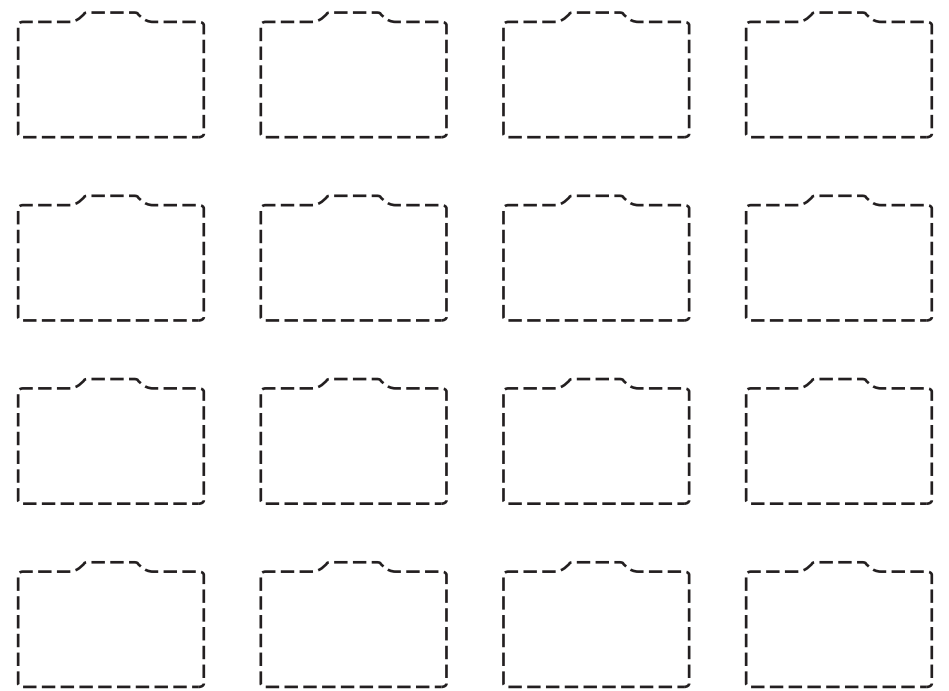
