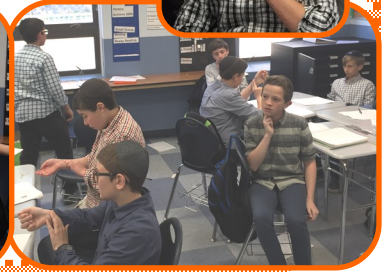
Middle School Updates

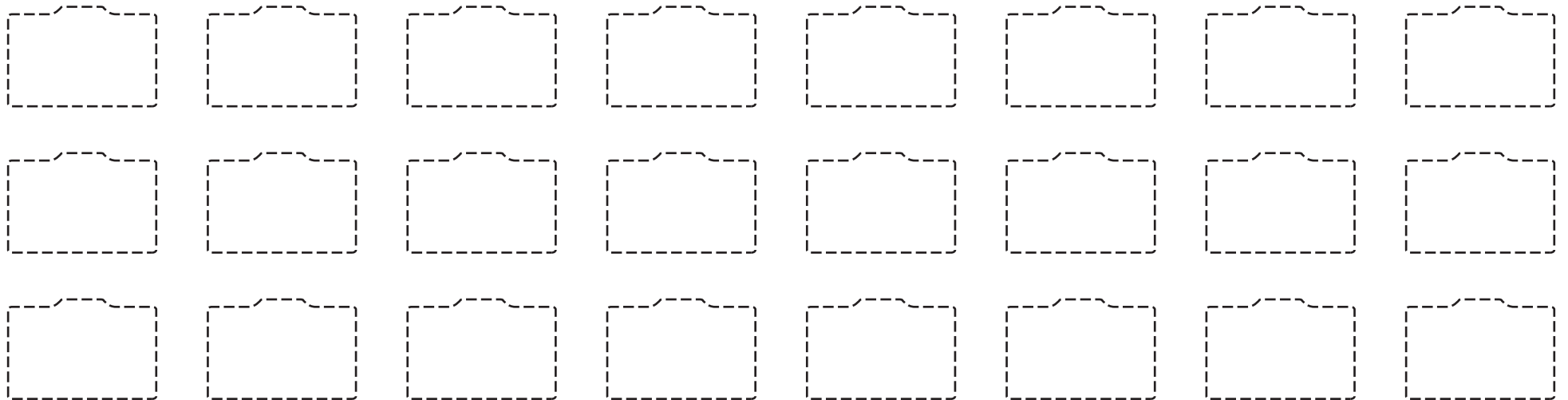
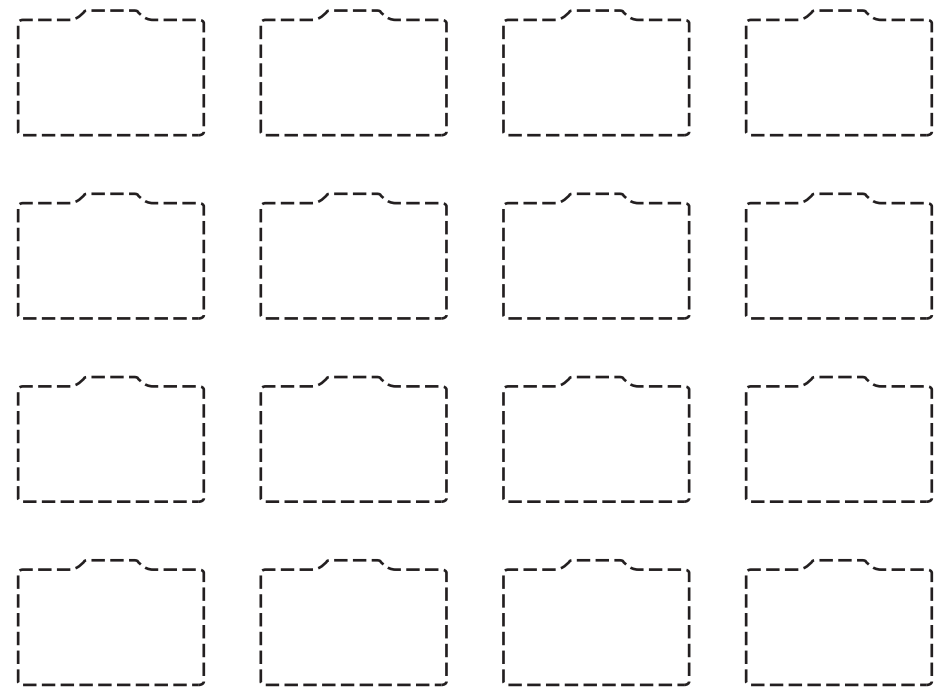
