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Parenting in the Parsha

פרשת פקודי Above Suspicion

אלה פקודי המשכן משכן העדת אשר פקד על־פי משה עבדת הלוים ביד איתמר בן־אהרן הכהן

These are the records of the Tabernacle, the Tabernacle of the Pact, which were drawn up at Moses' bidding—the work of the Levites under the direction of Ithamar son of Aaron the priest.

Once the work of the *Mishkan* was complete, Moshe said to them "Come and let's make an accounting together." Immediately, all *Yisroel* gathered... and he accounted for what he spent for each and every thing.

Caesar's wife must be above suspicion

Julius Caesar

Let's spend some time on teenagers. I know what you're thinking. All the time in the world won't be enough for teenagers. You are correct, and we will revisit teenagers many times in this work. But, for now, let's narrow our focus to one point. Teenagers are often highly focused on the idea that as long as you're doing what you are supposed to be doing, who cares what other people think?

Parents of teenagers and those who have been teenagers themselves know what I am talking about. Try getting a teenage boy to get a presentable haircut. Try telling a teenage girl how to wear her hair or how to dress for a specific occasion. Try explaining to them that certain styles of dress might cast suspicion on them as being less than upstanding. Aside from becoming surly and completely ignoring your advice, the teenager will typically launch into a lengthy monologue about how wrong it is to judge other people by appearances. They are right. But, they're wrong.


One of the most important lessons we can impart to our children is that we must deal with the world as it is, not with the ideal world as we wish it were. Of course people shouldn't judge others by externals. But they do, and so does your teenage child.

After constructing the *mishkan* from public donations, Moshe Rabbeinu gives a full, transparent accounting of every penny that went into the project. The Midrash cites this reckoning as an example of the principle of *v'hiyisem n'kiyim meiHashem u'miyisrael*, the value that one must always be above suspicion, not just before G-d, but above suspicion before his fellow man, as well. Moshe Rabbeinu, the one man who did not chase after the loot at the Yam Suf, the selfless leader of the Jewish people who was independently wealthy, had no real need to answer to anyone when he completed the *mishkan*. Anyone who might have accused him of impropriety would have certainly been in the wrong. Moshe, however, was guided by the principle of remaining above suspicion.

Moshe Rabbeinu becomes a reference point for us to be able to discuss these ideas with our children, this value of being above suspicion. We can also bring this point home to our children in ways that are understandable to them. In an era where any photographic image is available at our fingertips, we can play a little game with our children. Find a picture of a respectable looking man, either in a suit or a lab coat. Find another picture of a less than respectable looking fellow with various piercings and tattoos. Ask the child the following question: you have been asked to recommend one of these two people as a heart surgeon for a seriously ill person. What's your gut reaction? Why?

You can substitute lawyer, accountant, or any other professional they might want to patronize. Now, discuss. What makes you decide based on appearances? Explain human nature to your children and the fact that you never get a second chance to make a first impression. Most important, explain to them that in many aspects of life we would love for people to act in the ideal fashion and rarely will they. We need to be ruled by pragmatism over notions of idealism in other people. And we always must remain above suspicion.


