## **Parenting in the Parsha**

#### פרשת ויקרא On Deaf Ears

ויקרא אל־משה וידבר ה' אליו מאהל מועד לאמר

The LORD called to Moses and spoke to him from the Tent of Meeting, saying:

מאהל מועד .מְלַמֵד שֶׁהָיָה הַקּוֹל נִפְסָק וְלֹא הָיָה יוֹצֵא חוּץ לָאֹהֶל; יָכוֹל מִפְּנֵי שֶׁהַקּוֹל נָמוּהָ, תַּ"ל אֶת הַקּוֹל, מַהוּ הַקּוֹל? הוּא הַקּוֹל הַמְפֹרָשׁ בִּתְהִלִים קוֹל ה' בַּפֹחַ קוֹל ה' בֵּהַדַר קוֹל ה' שׁבֵר אַרַזִים(תהילים ב"ט,)אָם בֵּן לַמַה נֵאֵמַר מֵאֹהֵל מוֹעַד? מִלַמֵד שֵׁהַיָה הַקוֹ

This teaches us that the Voice broke off and did not issue beyond the appointed tent. One might think that this was so because the Voice was a very low one! Scripture, however, states, (Numbers 7:89) "(when he entered the tent he heard) the Voice". What does it mean by the Voice? It was the Voice that is so minutely described in Psalms, (29:4, 5) "The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is full of majesty. The voice of the Lord breaketh the cedars. But if this be so (that it was a very powerful voice), why does Scripture state, "(and the Lord spoke to him) from the appointed tent" (באהל מועד and does not state (באהל מועד)? Because it intends to tell us that the Voice broke off and that it was heard only in the tent)

The way we talk to our children becomes their inner voice

There is perhaps no more frustrating experience in parenthood than the feeling that you are not being listened to at all. You talk to your children, offer them sound advice, admonish them gently, and attempt to guide them to the proper path. And, they completely ignore you. No matter what, it seems that your advice has fallen on deaf ears, and the problem only gets worse as your children enter the teenage years. Surprisingly enough, as your children reach adulthood, you might discover that a lot more than you thought sunk in.


The Torah tells us that Hashem spoke to Moshe in a loud and powerful voice that could nevertheless be heard only by him. If nobody else can hear, why the loud voice? Perhaps, there is a lesson here about hearing and listening. Oftentimes, even when someone is not actively listening and is not aware that they are hearing something, there is subtle, subliminal effect on them. In Thinking Fast and Slow, Daniel Kahnemann reports on numerous studies that have shown people to be affected by things that they hear even when they don't realize they're hearing them. That principle very much applies to parenthood as well.

When we speak with our children in their youth and they seem to completely ignore our advice and ideas, those ideas often become embedded in the recesses of their minds. It may take decades for the values we have shared with them to enter their consciousness, and they may not even be aware that they got those ideas from us, but the thought, like a seed, is planted in the brain, ready to sprout when needed.

The *navi* compares words of Torah to the rain that falls to the earth and waters the vegetation. The rain falls to earth and then dries without seeming to have made any impact, but it has. It has begun the process of growth in the seeds and the vegetation, and later, when the rain is long-forgotten, its fruits will be enjoyed in the yield of the crops. So it is with sagacious words of Torah. They will come down like the rain and then be lost and seemingly forgotten, consigned to oblivion with no visible impact. But, like the rain, they remain, dormant and hidden away, ready to bear the fruit when the time is ripe.

So, when you talk to your kids and are sure that you are getting nowhere, don't give up and don't stop. They're not listening, but they are hearing and you'll likely hear them tell your grandchildren what you are telling them today.


