Lesson is given over in an entertaining and captivating way. Kids are glued.

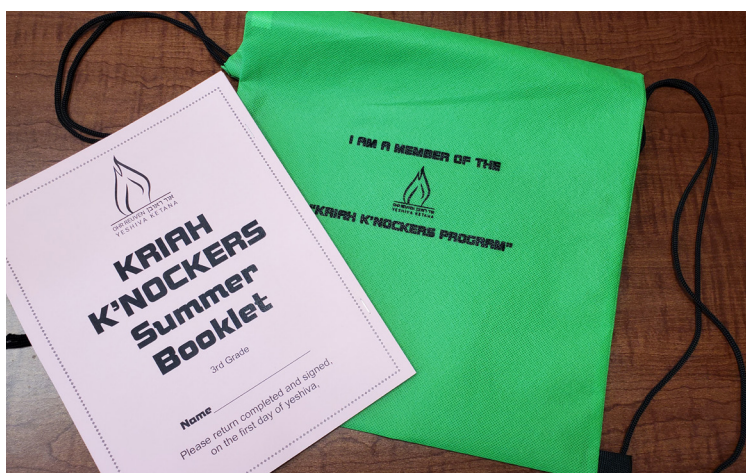
Boys are asking questions that prove their deep involvement.
