

PARENTING in PARSHA



לך לך It's a Miracle

A miracle is an event so unlikely as to be almost impossible. By that definition, I've just proven that you are a miracle.

-Dr. Ali Binazir

What are the odds of your being born? What are the odds of any one of your children having been born? They are slim, impossibly slim.

According to a blog post by Dr. Ali Binazir published in 2012, the odds of any one person being born are "1 in $10^{2,685,000}$ – yes, that's a 10 followed by 2,685,000 zeroes!" In other words, by mathematical odds, it is highly improbable to near impossible for any of us to be here, and yet, here we are.

Binazir arrives at that astronomical number by calculating the odds of anyone's parents meeting and staying together long enough to actually have children. To that, he adds the mathematical probability of them succeeding in conceiving a child. That, in turn is layered upon the statistical chance of every single one of your ancestors having survived to child bearing age, having found a suitable spouse and having succeeded in bearing children of their own. The bottom line of all his calculations is that the odds of any of us actually being here are pretty much zero. And yet, here we are.

Rav Shamshon Raphael Hirsch believes that displaying miracle of our existence is the driving force behind the unusual circumstances surrounding the inception of the Jewish People. Why does Hashem wait until Avraham and Sarah have reached an age where the thought of them bearing children is laughable before first granting them a son? It is for us to know for all time how truly impossible our existence actually is.

Rav Hirsch's observation is applicable to the Jewish nation as a whole, as well as to each individual ever born. We are all a miracle. Unfortunately, too often we forget just what a miracle it is that any of us are here.

That is vitally important for parents.

By nature, couples who have difficulty having children will

cherish those children just a little more when they finally arrive. You might even hear a mother or father refer to one of their children as "my miracle baby." When you see your child as a miracle, you tend to have a little more patience for the trials and tribulations of child-rearing. If your child is a miracle child, then the simple pleasures and joys of parenting become sources of great pride and delight and the lows become a little more tolerable and less disturbing. No matter what happens, you always remind yourself that your child is a miracle.

What if you were to suddenly discover that your child is really a miracle child, a mathematical impossibility gifted to you by Hashem, Himself? Guess what, you just did.

Now that we know, thanks to Dr. Ali Binazir, that all our children are miracles, how will that affect the way we view them? How will it change the way we cherish our children, the time we spend with them, and how much we enjoy just the fact that they exist.

As we all know, parenting brings its share of difficulties and challenges. It is no walk in the park. It is filled with angst, stress, sleepless nights, and hard work. That can be very daunting indeed. But, ask yourself, would you trade all that anxiety, lost sleep, and stress for a miracle?

Like Yitzchak before us, all our children are an impossible miracle. So, the next time you're ready to pull your hair out, pause, take a deep breath, and behold the wondrous miracle before you.
