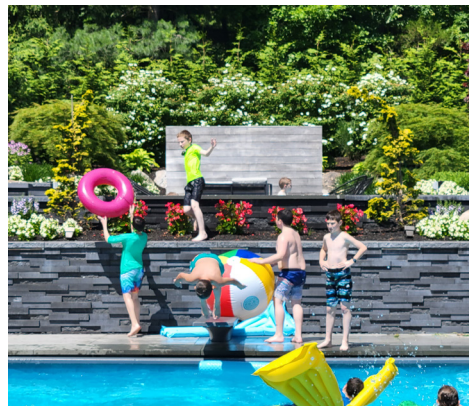


Last day in Mrs. Radzik's 1st grade class! Each student wrote their names and phone numbers on a paper and put it in the balloon and let it fly away for someone to find.

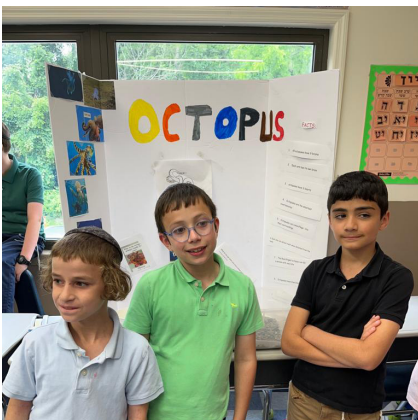

**PROGRAM:** A booklet of the *halachas* that we learned this past year under the LULLAY program. The schedule begins this coming Sunday, June 26. It runs weekly Sunday-Thursday 26 and ends on Monday, August 29th.



The it works is as follows:

- A page a day, each page has a date on top. On the page there is a *halacha*, *hashkafa* or a story. At the bottom of the page there is question with a number and the answers are in multiple choice format.
- Read it, answer the question, call into the system, enter your user ID which is on the front of the booklet and follow instructions to answer the question.
- Points will be accumulated for every question.
- The system will only allow to enter the question for that specific date.



**REWARDS?** Yes!! There will be different prize levels upon return to yeshiva. The system will give us a report of all the points that your son accumulated during the summer.

# “Kriah K’nockers Program”

Reminder: Kriah Knockers Info

Dear Parents of talmidim in outgoing grades P-4 שיחיו,

As in previous years, our successful summer Kriah K’nockers program will continue with a twist. The program is simple, easy, parent/child friendly and GESHMAK!

 **PROGRAM:** Your son brought home today a Kriah booklet with a daily schedule. (P1A talmidim should expect it in the mail in the next few days.) The schedule begins this coming Sunday, June 26 and ends on Monday, August 29th. It runs weekly Sunday-Thursday (except for tisha b’av).

 **This year we created a sophisticated, but easy to use, system to enter the daily Kriah. The way to works is as follows:**

- Your son will read the page for that day as per schedule that was sent home.
- He will then call the into the system 845-539-2222
- Enter his user ID, printed on the inside cover of the booklet
- Put in the correct page # for that day. Please note: you can only enter the page for that day, the system will not let you enter a page that is meant to be read another day.
- Parent puts in their private code (which is in this email) to confirm that your son actually read the page.
- The amount of points that your son received will be announced.
- You can at any time press #4 to hear the instructions

 **REWARDS? Yes!!**

- There will be different prize levels upon return to yeshiva. Level 1, 400+ points, level 2: 800+ points, level 3 1000+. The system will give us a report of all the points that your son accumulated during the summer.

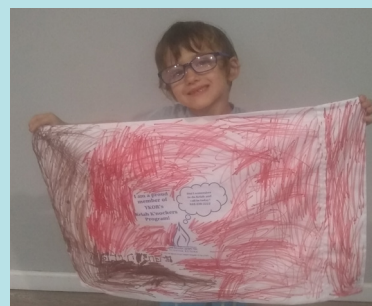
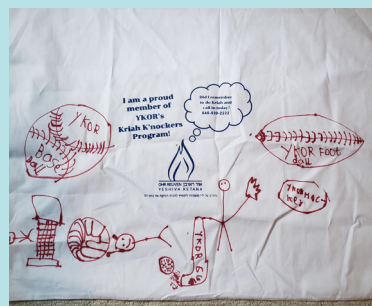
 **Remember:** CONSISTENCY = FLUENCY.
