Middle School Updates

Do you know why an air-craft carrier carrying hundreds of supplies, soldiers, airplanes does not sink? The 7th graders do! They learned about that as part of their science unit on buoyancy and the Archimedes Principle. They are also looking forward to explaining these concepts to younger students at YKOR at the upcoming PBL fair on February 25.

What is the Bernoulli Principle? How does a plane wing generate lift? What were the Wright Brothers known for? Ask any 8th grader and he'll tell you the answers. We're diving deep - or flying high :) - into our PBL unit on Airplanes. As we investigate the history and science of flying as a class, the boys are busy investigating their own planes in small groups. Some examples of the planes that the boys are researching include: the Red Baron, the Enola Gay, the Concord, Air Force 1, and the f35 fighter jet. Check back after winter break to see models of these planes (and others!) at our annual PBL Fair.

Healthy Habits

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend that everyone 6 months of age and older receive a yearly flu vaccine to protect against serious illness caused by the flu. How well the flu vaccine works each year partly depends on how well the viruses in the vaccine match the viruses that are making people sick. Keeping Hashem in Mind-Always


Baruch Hashem, Chasdei Hashem, B'ezras Hashem, Im Yirtzah Hashem:
