Yeshivas Ohr Reuven Holds 26th Annual Dinner

In an overwhelming display of warmth and unity, Yeshivas Ohr Reuven held its 26th Annual Dinner May 13th at the Sheraton Mahwah Hotel. The capacity crowd of over 600 Yeshiva faculty, parents, alumni and friends gathered to celebrate the achievements of this remarkable *mosad*.

The Dinner Chairman, Rabbi Chaim Silver opened with introductory remarks and lent the evening a parent perspective on the *ahavas Hashem*, *ahavas hatorah*, and *ahavas yisroel* the Yeshiva imbues in each of its *talmidim*.

The *Rosh HaYeshiva*, HaRav Bezael Rudinsky, Shlita, spoke of the Yeshiva's commitment to the *Talmidim* and how the Torah learned must go with them, wherever their lives may lead.

In a special "Kesser Rabbanus" *Smicha* presentation, Five *Talmidim* (pictured above) were awarded *Smicha* from the *Rosh HaYeshiva*. The evening's honorees included Mr. and Mrs. Ami Schwab as Guests of honor, Mr. Zev Feder as Alumnus of the Year, and Rabbi And Mrs. Aaron Spivak received the *Hakaras Hatov* Award.

Learning with *Simcha*

It looked like *Simchas Torah* in Rabbi Biller's third-grade classroom this week as the students voices singing *משה אמת ותורתו* *משה אמת* echoed throughout the hallway. A peek inside the classroom at the enthusiastically singing and jumping *talmidim* might have had one puzzled as to what time of year it actually was.

The simple explanation is that the third graders have been learning *פרשת קרח* in depth for weeks. To illustrate how *קרח* went down into the depths of the earth, all the while shouting, "*משה* is true!" was too good of an opportunity to pass up. And so the *talmidim* jumped up to show that they are not part of *קרח's* ideology, but rather have *אמונה* in *Hashem*, His *Torah* and His *משה רבינו*, who is our leader *נביא נאמן*.

Continuing the Chain of History at West Point

Last week, Mrs. Stein's fourth-graders experienced a picture perfect, enjoyable afternoon at West Point. The trip including hiking with impressive, scenic views along the way and visits to places where the history lessons of the Revolutionary War years were brought to life.

The fourth graders stood at the spot where the American soldiers blocked British attempts to control the riverways. The students saw cannons used in the war effort and the Great Hudson River Chain designed to discourage British ships from sailing up the river. The chain was an impressive engineering feat, the combined labor of hundreds of ironworkers, lumbermen, wagon drivers, river men, and soldiers. Twelve of the original chain links, plus a clevis and swivel were on display at West Point, just one facet of a mesmerizing afternoon that

allowed our fourth-graders to bring the American history out of the classroom and into real life.
