



Last Thursday, the YKOR middle school was treated to a very special visitor. Mr. Michael Loebenstein, great-grandfather of first-grader, Shimon Wincelberg came to yeshiva, on the anniversary of Kristallnacht, to discuss his personal experience at the time. Mr. Loebenstein, who grew up in a town called Eschwege, described how, as a seven-year-old boy, he saw the mobs passing through town on their way to destroy Jewish homes. He told the boys how his older brother and the town melamed courageously rescued some of the Sifrei torah from the shul, and how he eventually helped his father and brother smuggle their family sefer torah out of Germany.

The boys listened attentively as our speaker related how his family escaped Germany in the nick of time and built a new life in America. Our talmidim really felt like they had touched a piece of living history in meeting and hearing Mr. Loebenstein, and we thank him for gracing us with his presence.
