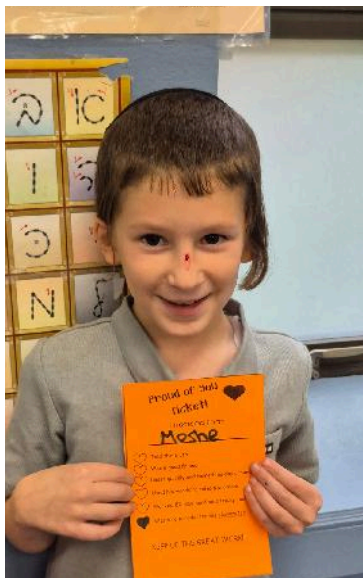
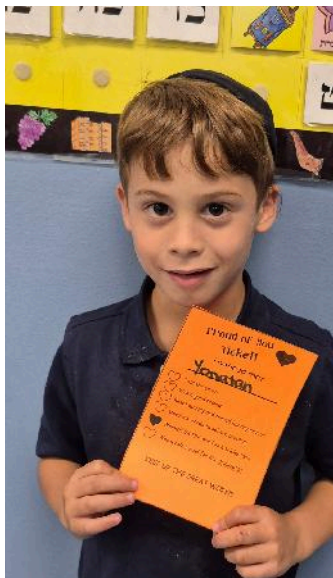

There is a fabulous story that is told about Rav Shlomo Heiman, the great Rosh Yeshiva of Torah Vodaas. Rav Heiman was known for his brilliant shiurim which he related with boundless energy and enthusiasm. One particular winter day, a blizzard crippled New York City and most of the talmidim could not make it to Yeshiva. Nevertheless, the Rosh HaYeshiva decided to proceed with his regular shiur which he delivered to the five young men who had managed to make it in to yeshiva that day. Rav Heiman presented the shiur with the same fire, energy, and enthusiasm as he did every other day to a full room of talmidim. One of the young men there asked Rav Heiman how and why he could be equally excited to deliver a shiur to five boys as to 100. Rav Heiman answered “when I give shiur, I am not speaking to the people in the room alone. I am speaking to their children and grandchildren until the end of time! How can I not be excited?

Rav Heiman’s response is an insight into the mind of an incredible rebbe with a broad view of the world and his role. It is also a vital insight into how we should approach our role as parents. When we raise our young children we are actually raising the parents of the next generation. How we conduct ourselves with our children will have a significant impact on how they conduct themselves with their children, and the pattern will continue down the line. If we view our role not just as parents, but as parenting educators, how different would our parenting interactions look?

Consider if you are in the midst of a challenging parenting moment, but instead of that moment taking place in the privacy of your home, it’s being played out in front of an audience of thousands who are tuned in to watch a demonstration of proper parenting methods. How might you act different? How carefully would you measure your words and your actions?

Now, consider that every one of your parenting moments has an audience of hundreds, if not thousands. You have Rav Shlomo Heiman’s snow day audience, not of talmidim, but of your children, their children and their children’s children for all time. Of course, if you get it wrong, there is always hope that they can unlearn the mistakes you have taught them and learn how to do it the right way. But, isn’t it our job as parents to teach them the right way to begin with?

Concepts from the Parsha

1) After 40 years of leading יִשְׂרָאֵל in the desert, it came time for מֹשֶׁה to be נִפְטָר. The date was אָדָר ז', 2488 (ב' תפח) and מֹשֶׁה was exactly 120 years old.

3) מֹשֶׁה warned the Yidden – as you passed through many different nations, you may have noticed their idols and felt that you want to worship them. Be aware, Hashem Yisborach, will punish the person who serves idols. Furthermore, if you serve idols, אֶרֶץ יִשְׂרָאֵל will become dry and not produce fruit. If you still continue to serve idols, the land of אֶרֶץ יִשְׂרָאֵל will no longer keep you and you will be sent into גְּלוּת.

4) Don't worry, said מֹשֶׁה, even when you have done עֲבִירוֹת, Hashem Yisborach, in His loving kindness, has given you the gift of תְּשׁוּבָה. Even though the wrong which was done was already done, if you do תְּשׁוּבָה, ה' will erase your עֲבִירוֹת as if they never happened.

5) When יִשְׂרָאֵל do תְּשׁוּבָה with their whole heart, Hashem Yisborach will end the גְּלוּת and will bring us back permanently to אֶרֶץ יִשְׂרָאֵל.

6) מֹשֶׁה told יִשְׂרָאֵל that the way to come close to ה' and to do proper תְּשׁוּבָה is through learning תּוֹרָה. Additionally, תּוֹרָה is the gift from ה' that brings us life in this world and the next.

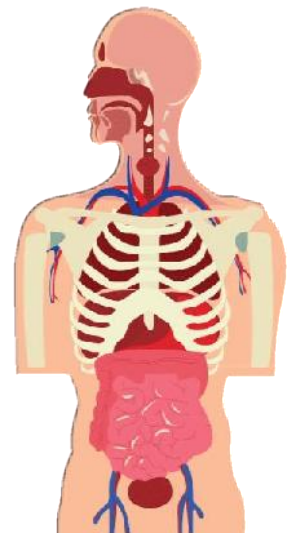
